From Our Moderator....

A group including Shirley Bookout, Barb Marlow, Mary Ann Matchett, John Starnes, Bob Weller, Sara Laroche, and Rev. Colby Smith met several times to review and revise the current constitution/by-laws. The new document entitled "Governance Guidelines" has been made available for review. Copies of the document are located in the library area of the church.

This new document combines the constitution and by-laws into one document which is very similar to the current document, although some of the terminology has changed. Some of these changes are a direct result of the listening sessions held earlier in the year. The major changes are as follows:

- Changes "members" to "active participants."
- Cleans up the nomination/election process.
- Reduces the size of the church board as has been discussed for several years.
- Defines ministry teams instead of committees.
- Eliminates the Financial Secretary position since the new counting system in cooperation with the Bookkeeper and Treasurer makes this unnecessary.
- Eliminates property committee and makes that a function of the Trustees and Property Manager.
- Combines Christian education, membership, and outreach into the Christian Life ministry team.

The new Governance Document will be voted on during a special congregational meeting to be held on November 25, immediately following the 9 a.m. Sanctuary service (approximately 10:15 p.m.)

Psalm 84:1-2


"How amiable are Thy tabernacles, O Lord of hosts! My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts of the Lord."
