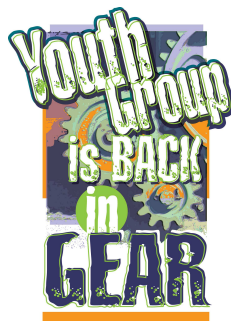

Taters and Talent:

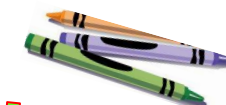
