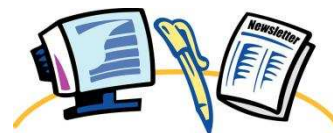

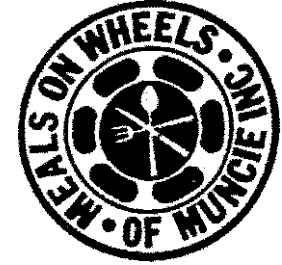

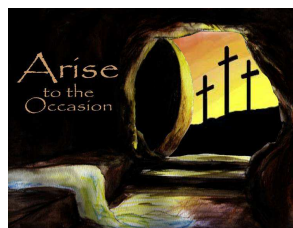

LENT AT HAZELWOOD

The following is an outline of some of the activities at Hazelwood.



March 15: Taters 'N Talent, 5 p.m., Cartwright Hall. Loaded baked potatoes and talent show.

March 29: Palm Sunday worship. Procession of palms. *Holy Week of Prayer begins.

April 2: Maundy Thursday dinner, 6 p.m., Cartwright Hall; service, with handwashing, 7 p.m., Sanctuary. Child Care, if requested.

April 4: Easter Egg Hunt, 10 a.m., for kids through 5th grade.

April 5: Easter morning worship. One combined service, 10 a.m., with baptisms.

*The prayer sign-up board will be out beginning March 1. You can sign up to take an hour at home, or in the Chapel, to be in prayer, as a part of your Holy Week experience.

Sign up for "Do Not Call" to help avoid scams!

The use of robocalls to solicit Hoosiers over the phone continues to rise, according to the Indiana Attorney General.

About 60 percent of the 10,000 Do Not Call complaints filed with the Attorney General's Telephone Privacy Division last year site robocalls.

Robocalling, which refers to the use of technology that automatically dials residential phone numbers and plays prerecorded messages, is illegal in Indiana under its Auto Dialer Law.

The Attorney General's Office continues to crack down on telemarketers or scammers who disregard Indiana's telephone privacy statutes. In 2014, the office took legal action against 11 Do Not Call or robocall violators, and obtained judgments and settlements totaling more than \$6 million.

As the attorney general's office works to uphold Hoosiers' privacy, members of the public who wish to block unwanted calls are encouraged to sign up for the state's Do Not Call list by visiting www.IndianaConsumer.com or calling (888) 834-9969.

Consumers can register their residential landline, cell, VOIP or prepaid wireless numbers on the Do Not Call list. Individuals do not need to re-register unless their address has changed.

To sign up or to confirm a number is already on the list, visit www.IndianaConsumer.com or call (888) 834- 9969. Out-of-state area codes can also be added as long as the billing address is located in Indiana.

Consumers who are registered and receive an unwanted call can file a complaint by visiting www.IndianaConsumer.com.
