WORSHIP SERVICE**

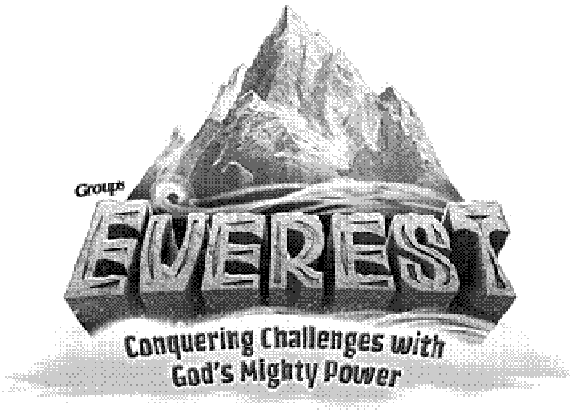
