Our youth and sponsors have raised over \$7,000.00 towards our summer mission trip goal of \$8,800.00. Why so much? We are returning to Give Kids the World! The last time our youth participated in GKTW they were transformed in many unexpected ways. And when talking to the youth about previous missions trips they attended, many of them talked about that mission trip more than any other. They did not talk about being in Orlando, or the DOC general conference, or spending a day at Disney World. They remembered GKTW.

So what is GKTW? It started thirty years ago when a young girl with leukemia had a wish to visit Orlando's theme parks. Unfortunately, the plans and accommodations took too long and her wish was never granted; time simply ran out, and the young girl passed away. This unfulfilled wished inspired one man to create GKTW so this would never happen again. Since then, Henri Landwirth has developed a 79-acre, nonprofit resort in Central Florida that provides weeklong, cost-free vacations to children with life-threatening illnesses and their families.

When a child is diagnosed with a life-threatening illness, a family's life changes forever. They face an obstacle course littered with doctor appointments, painful treatments, overwhelming expenses and endless worry. Parents who would do anything to see their child smile are forced to say "no" because of the risks and limitations the disease imposes. Energy vanishes, hope fades, and free time slips away. But when a family arrives at Give Kids The World Village, they quickly realize that this is a special place. Requests are granted and limitations are eliminated: "Yes, you can have ice cream for breakfast!"; "Yes, wheelchairs are allowed in that pool!"; "Yes, you can ride the train, again!"

Everything at GKTW is aimed at giving these families time together and allowing the children to smile and rediscover joy. GKTW is run purely on donations and volunteer work. This is where our youth group comes in to the picture: there are various ways we will serve from serving food and ice cream to running rides and entertaining the children at various attractions. Striving to Be the Best!


One of the things we have been diligently working on this year in the preschool is getting to the next level in excellent care and education for our children. I'm excited to tell you that we are ready for our inspection on June 3, 2016 to achieve our next certification!

This next level is called VCP (Voluntary Certification Process). There are currently 32 ministries in Delaware County and 210 in the surrounding counties. If all goes as planned at our inspection, we will be 1 of only 3 ministries in Delaware County to have achieved VCP recognition!

What does it mean to be VCP Certified? It means that we are able to have the use of a kitchen so we could, at some point, offer lunches. We would receive free educational equipment. Our staff will have more opportunities for free training. It also means that our facility is more advanced in our safety procedures with a completely hard-wired fire system, proper lighting in the entire facility, and a safer playground with a completely fenced in play area. It also means we ensure continued education for our teachers.

Once we have officially secured our VCP status, we will be able to begin the Indiana Paths to QUALITYTM Program. As we progress along the Paths to QUALITYTM Program, we will have access to a mentor to guide us along the way to bettering the education and facility we offer our families. There are also incentive rewards along the way, which will give us more opportunities for free educational equipment, continued education for our teachers, and ultimately, we will become eligible for financial and technical support to reach the final level of National Accreditation!

Our ultimate goal? We want to be able to offer our families the very best a preschool ministry can offer: a place for children to play safely and receive the best education as they grow in the love of God. Please join us in prayer as we continue to strive to be the very best Preschool in Muncie, Indiana!
