

#### CAN'T SEE THE FOREST (OR THE CHURCH!) FOR THE TREES

Have you ever told someone you attend Hazelwood Church and the conversation went something like this?

- "Where is that?"
- "Right on University Ave., just east of Ball State."
- "There's a church there?"
- "Sure is. Right past the Village."
- "Past the Village? I've never seen a church there, just a bunch of houses."
- "You remember where that green fence was?"
- "Oh! You mean the big white mansion. That's a church? I thought that was just some rich person's home!"
- "Well, the church offices are in there, but the church building is just to the left of the mansion."
- "I've never noticed it there before!"

How can we expect to grow as a church if no one even knows we're here? They've all seen the mansion, but very few have ever noticed the church. And it's no wonder! As you drive down University all you see are houses, the big white mansion... and TREES! As beautiful as those trees are, there are so many so close together that they all but completely block the view of our wonderful church!
