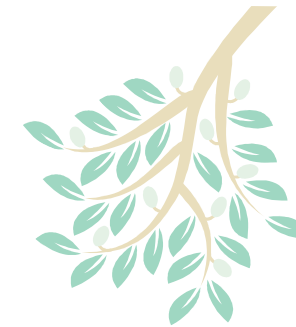
## We Wish to Welcome!
