The food on the table took us away from her tour, but if it hadn't she could have shown me many more things.

It was cute because she's a little kid, and I didn't mind. She was showing me the things that were important to her: her toys and room and things. She wanted me to see these things, and she wanted my attention. It's no challenge to give attention to a cute little kid, but I wonder how often I listen to someone tell me what's most important to him or her. How often has someone wanted me to listen to what's most important? Probably plenty of times. How often have I really listened? Probably not enough.

There's a verse from James I often quote. It says we should be "quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become angry" (1:19). Those are good words to live by, and when we do, we might be giving another the opportunity to describe what is most important. Someone, when you gather for Thanksgiving, might have something to tell you. It may not seem like much, but you could give a beautiful gift just by listening.
